The Vest_® Airway Clearance System **Guidelines for Determining Garment Size**

To obtain an accurate measurement for inflatable garment size:

- 1. Take a deep breath and hold it.
- 2. Using a tape measure, loosely measure the inches around the widest part of your chest; women should measure at the bust line.
- 3. Consult the chart below to determine your inflatable garment size.

Inflatable Garments	(Reusable)	
	Fitting the Chest Vest	
Commonly Prescribed Pressure Settings: 1-4	 The Chest Vest should fit comfortably close to the under arms; make sure the Chest Vest fits close to the body without being uncomfortably snug For the best fit, inhale deeply, and then secure both back panel tabs to the front panel. Make sure the Chest Vest fits close to the body without being uncomfortably snug To tighten the fit at the bottom edge, angle the back panel tabs downward To loosen the fit at the bottom edge, angle the back panel tabs downward 	
	Fitting the Full Vest	
	 Put the Full Vest on so the closures are in front; connect the closures so the Full Vest fits loosely over the chest The Full Vest should fit comfortably close to the under arms, and the bottom of the garment should hit at top of hip bone. Prior to inflation of the Full Vest adjust the Full Vest to fit close to the body without being uncomfortably snug 	
Commonly Prescribed Pressure Settings: 4-6		
	Fitting the Wrap Vest	
Commonly Prescribed Pressure Settings: 1-4	 Center the deflated Wrap Vest (bladder portion) over the front of the chest Take a deep breath, and fasten the Wrap Vest making sure that the garment fits close to the underarms, but is not uncomfortable 	

NOTE: For patient comfort, it is recommended that a single layer of cotton clothing be worn beneath the garment.
